DRESSING FORCEPS

Use to hold and manipulate dressings

and other materials during wound

care or other medical procedures

APPLICATIONS



Use to hold and manipulate delicate tissues during surgical procedures, laboratory work, and dental procedures.

DESIGN



- Fine, serrated jaws for a precise grip on tissues without causing damage.
- Has the option of 1x2. 2x3, 3x4, or 4x5 teeth.
- Long, thin handles and a wider, flatter tip to prevent damage to dressings and wound sites
- May be smooth tipped, without any teeth or serrations, or they may be serrated.
